

General Information about OverDrive eBooks

- You will use your library card number to check out eBooks. Your library card must be in good standing.
- You cannot check out eBooks with an Internet card.
- If your library card is new, was recently replaced or renewed, or if money was recently paid to unblock your library card, it will take up to one hour before you can check out eBooks.
- If your card number changes (i.e. lost card), email your new card number to info@mymcpl.org so your OverDrive account can be updated and your holds and checkouts can be moved to the new card number. This email address also appears on the OverDrive website's Sign In page.
- You can have a total of 20 OverDrive items (eBooks and audiobooks) checked out at one time.
- eBooks can be checked out for 7, 14, or 21 days. You select the checkout period when you are checking out the eBook. You can check in an eBook before it is due if you finish it early.
- You do not have to return your eBooks when you are done reading them. The title is immediately returned to the library once the lending period has expired, although the file will remain on your computer or device until you delete it. If the lending period has expired, you will not be able to open the file.
- You cannot renew eBooks. You can check out a title again as long as it is available.
- You may place 20 OverDrive items (eBooks and audiobooks) on hold at one time.
- If you place an item on hold, you will receive an email when the item becomes available. You will have three days from the time the email notification is sent to sign in to OverDrive and check out the item.
- eBook checkouts and holds through OverDrive do not appear on your Mid-Continent account.
- The Buy It Now feature will display an option to purchase an eBook or digital audiobook from a retail partner. A portion of the purchase price goes to support the library's digital collection.
- The Recommend feature will display an option to suggest adding titles to the digital collection. Recommended titles will be evaluated and considered for purchase according to our Collection Management Policy and budget.
- Mid-Continent's public computers can be used to search for and check out eBooks using the OverDrive Digital Downloads website. The public computers can be used to transfer eBooks to only Kindle devices since special software is not required for Kindle devices. (The same guidelines apply to staff computers. Connecting your non-Kindle device to a staff computer will interfere with the authorization of your device and will render it unusable with your own computer and software.)
- Most eReaders are compatible with OverDrive. A full list of compatible devices is available on OverDrive's Digital Downloads website.
- You can use a Mac with OverDrive eBooks.
