
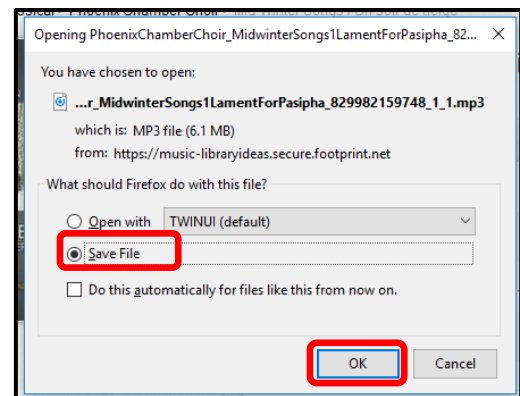



Downloading Freegal Music Using Mozilla Firefox

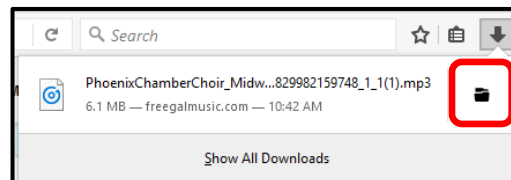
Freegal Music limits library users to 5 downloads per week. The week begins on Monday at 12:01 a.m.

1. Visit our website at mymcpl.org.
2. Hover over Books, Movies, Music at the top of the page.
3. Select eMusic under the Download & Stream section.
4. Click Freegal Music.
5. Login using your library card number.
6. Locate a song or video you wish to download by searching or browsing.
7. Click the  button to either download the song or video, or add it to your wishlist. (Note: when you click Download Now, you will use one of your five weekly downloads regardless of whether or not you cancel the download. Music videos cost TWO of your weekly downloads.)
8. An Opening Filename dialog box will appear asking if you want to open or save the file.
9. Click the radio button next to Save File.
10. Click OK.

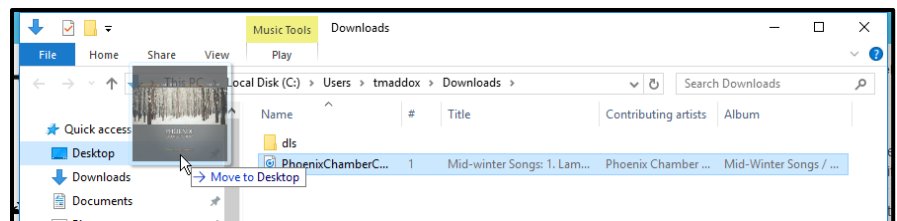


11. Once the file has finished downloading, click on the blue arrow  in the upper right corner to display your recent downloads.

12. Click the folder icon next to the download.



13. Move the file to your Desktop or your preferred location by dragging and dropping the file.



14. To listen to the song or to view the video with your media player software or sync to your mobile device, double-click the file from your saved location.
15. Use your media player software to sync to your mobile device as desired.
