

Using the *Freegal Music* App for a Mobile Device or Tablet

Freegal Music apps are available!

Freegal Music offers free mobile apps in the Apple App Store, Google Play Store, and the Amazon store (Kindle Fire 3rd generation and up).

How do I find my local library in the *Freegal Music* app?

Open the app. Enter your zip code, and a list of libraries within a 60-mile radius that subscribe to *Freegal Music* will appear. You can also enter “Independence” in the search box. Select Mid-Continent Public Library from the list.

How do I log in to the *Freegal Music* app?

Use your library card number to log in. If you need assistance, please contact your local library.

What are the different parts of the *Freegal Music* app?

- **Home:** The most frequently downloaded songs are listed. From here you may also access your Recently Played songs, as well as your wishlist.
- **Browse:** The top artists, new arrivals, genres, playlists, and more are listed in the browse section.
- **Search:** Search for artists and albums.
- **My Music:** Pages for all the songs, music videos, and audiobooks you have downloaded using the app appear here. You can sort the song list by date, artist, and alphabetically.
 - **Playlists:** You can create playlists to organize your music. Select Create New Playlist, enter a name, select songs to add, and select Done. *Freegal Music* also has premade lists available to listen to.
 - **Music Videos:** The videos you have downloaded using the app are listed. You can sort the list by artist, song, and album.
 - **Audiobooks:** The audiobooks you have downloaded are listed in this section.
- **Settings:** In the upper right-hand corner of the app, you can access the app settings. The settings will show you what library card you are using and how many downloads you still have available. This is where you log out of the *Freegal Music* app.

How many times can I download the same song or video?

You can download a song or video only three times using the app. Also, if you log in to your account from a computer, the song or video will be listed on your My Music page and you can download it up to two more times. The app and the My Music page only lets you redownload songs from this week and last week. This allows you to download a copy to your computer for the purpose of having it in your iTunes library or other software. Once you have downloaded a song or video twice from the My Music page, the song or video disappears from your list.

How do I transfer items from the app to my computer?

Plug your device into your computer.

- For Android and Fire devices: Using your computer, navigate to your *Freegal Music* folder on your device. Copy and paste the folder to your preferred location.
- For iOS devices: Open iTunes on your computer. Select your device. Select File Sharing. Select the *Freegal Music* app. Select the *Freegal Music* folder (may be named with your library card number or a series of numbers). Save to your preferred location.

How do I transfer items from my computer to the app?

Plug your device into your computer. Note: Only MP3 songs can be transferred to the app.

- For Android and Fire devices: Using your computer, navigate to the item you want to transfer. Copy the file. Navigate to the device’s *Freegal Music* folder, and then to the folder named with your library card number. Paste the file into this folder. (NOTE: The *Freegal Music* folder will only be visible if you have already downloaded items in the *Freegal Music* app.)
- For iOS devices: Open iTunes on your computer. Select your device. Select File Sharing. Select the *Freegal Music* app. Select Add, navigate to the song you wish to transfer and highlight it. Select Open. Sync your device.
