
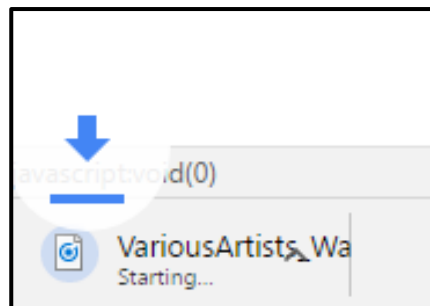


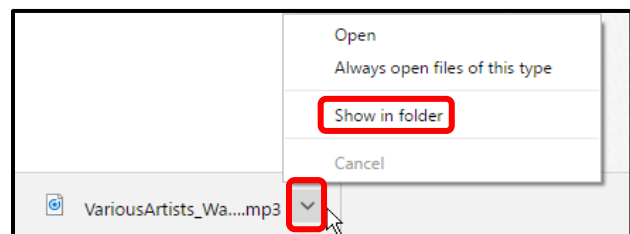
## Downloading Freegal Music Using Google Chrome

Freegal Music limits library users to five downloads per week. The week begins on Monday at 12:01 a.m.

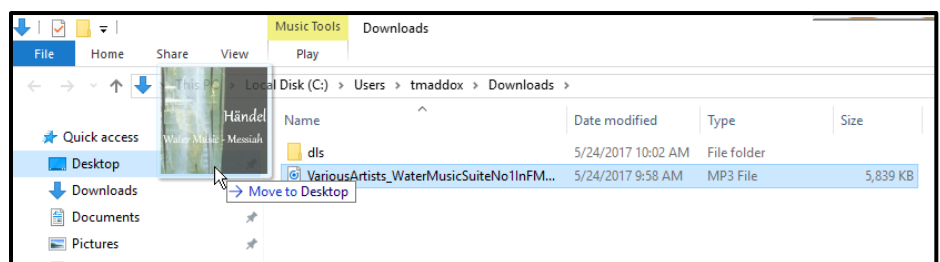
1. Visit our website at [mymcpl.org](http://mymcpl.org).
2. Hover over Books, Movies, Music at the top of the page.
3. Select eMusic under the Download & Stream section.
4. Click Freegal Music.
5. Login using your library card number.
6. Locate a song or video you wish to download by searching or browsing.
7. Click the  button to either download the song or video, add it to your wishlist, or add it to your playlist. (Note: when you click Download Now, you will use one of your five weekly downloads regardless of whether or not you cancel the download. Music videos cost TWO of your weekly downloads.)
8. A large arrow on the left of the screen will point to the file downloading to the tray of Google Chrome.



9. Click on the arrow to the side of the file to display a menu of options. Click Show in folder.



10. Move the file to your Desktop or your preferred location by dragging and dropping the file.



11. To listen to the song or to view the video with your media player software or sync to your mobile device, double-click the file from your saved location.
12. Use your media player software to sync to your mobile device as desired.
