
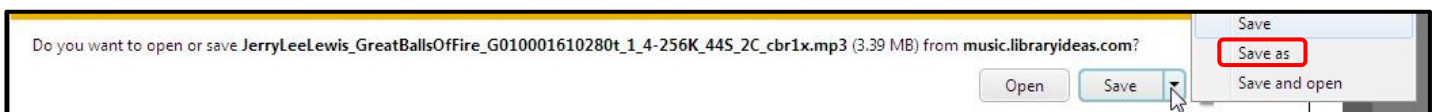


Downloading Freegal Music Using Internet Explorer 9, 10, and 11

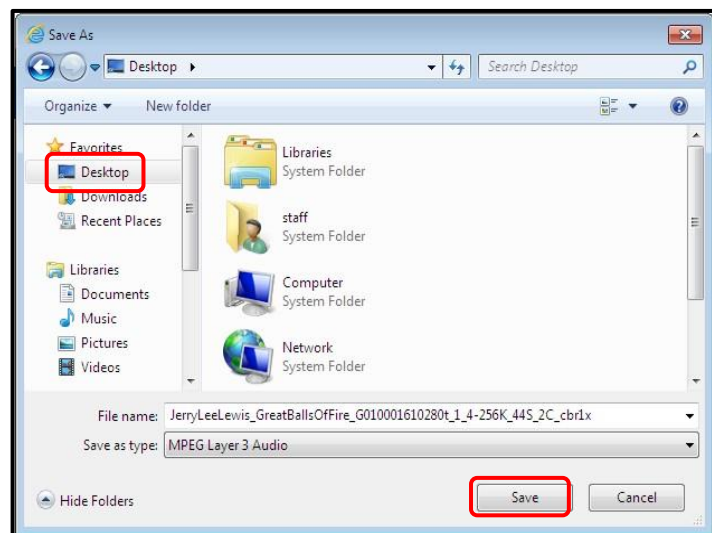
Freegal Music limits library users to five downloads per week. The week begins on Monday at 12:01 a.m.

1. Visit our website at mymcpl.org.
2. Hover over Books, Movies, Music at the top of the page.
3. Select eMusic under the Download & Stream section.
4. Click Freegal Music.
5. Login using your library card number.
6. Locate a song or video you wish to download by searching or browsing.
7. Click the  button to either download the song or video, or add it to your wish list. (Note: when you click Download Now, you will use one of your five weekly downloads regardless of whether or not you cancel the download. Music videos cost TWO of your weekly downloads.)
8. At the bottom of the Internet Explorer window, a box will appear with options to open or save the file.



9. Click the arrow next to Save to display the menu of options. Click Save as.

10. Save the file on your Desktop or in your preferred location.



11. To listen to the song or to view the video with your media player software or sync to your mobile device, click Open.



12. Use your media player software to sync to your mobile device as desired.
