




Pinterest is a virtual bulletin board app that allows you to organize and share all the beautiful, fun, and interesting things you find on the web.

Your home feed is the center of Pinterest, where you'll find billions of ideas called Pins. When you discover Pins you love, save them to boards to keep your ideas organized and easy to find.



PINTEREST LANGUAGE

Like most social media, Pinterest has its own language. This language is mostly composed of icons you interact with to perform certain tasks on Pinterest.



Search bar

Home feed

Toolbar

PINTEREST LANGUAGE

Search bar: Search for Pins, boards, people or hashtags

Home feed: A place where you'll find Pins, people, and brands you may love based on your recent activity


Toolbar: Holds icons for different locations on Facebook

PINTEREST LANGUAGE


Your home feed is a never-ending scroll of colorful, appealing photos called Pins.



- You can have up to 200,000 Pins on your Pinterest profile.
- Pins are ideas from around the web that people on Pinterest find and save. Each Pin links back to the website it was saved from.
- If you click through the Pin, you can learn more—like how to make it or where to buy it.

PINTEREST LANGUAGE

Boards are where you save and organize your Pins.



- You can make boards for anything and everything—save your recipes to one board and your dream vacation destinations to another.
- You can have up to 500 boards on Pinterest.
- Name your boards and arrange them on your profile however you want.

PINTEREST LANGUAGE


Depending on your device, you may have different options than what are listed here in this handout.



Home: A feed of Pins from people, topics, and boards you choose to follow



Following: A dedicated space for the latest Pins from the people and boards you follow



Notifications: Find updates about your Pins and boards



Saved: Displays boards you've created and Pins you've saved

PINTEREST LANGAUGE

As you explore Pinterest, you may find fun and interesting ideas you want to share or save. When you tap and hold on a Pin, you have the following options:



Save: Save the Pin to one of your Boards



Hide: See fewer Pins related to this one





Send: Share the Pin with someone on or off Pinterest



More: Access other options like Unfollow, Report, or Shop if applicable for that Pin

CREATING A BOARD

Creating a board to hold your Pins can be done two ways:



- **From your profile** by tapping on 'Saved' in the toolbar. Tap the plus sign in the upper right-hand corner to add a new Pin or a new board.

OR

- **From your home feed**, you can create a board at the same time as you're saving a new Pin. Find a Pin to save. When Pinterest asks you to 'Choose board,' scroll down and tap 'Create board.'
- Fill in the board name and tap 'Create.'

PINNING TO BOARDS

Pinterest is a collection of ideas and inspirations from all around the web for everyone to discover. You can even add your own Pins to the mix.

There are three ways to save to boards:


- **Add from your Pinterest home feed:** Tap and hold on a Pin to show the Pin options. Slide up to the pushpin icon to save the Pin to a board.
- **Upload photos from your device:** Tap the plus sign in the upper right corner of your profile. Choose 'Photo' to search your device's photo gallery.
- **Save from your mobile browser:** In the same way you would share an article to a friend in a message or in an email, share a recipe, article, or craft to Pinterest by tapping your device's respective share icon.

PINNING TO BOARDS

When you share a Pin from your mobile browser to Pinterest, you choose the photo for your new visual bookmark before adding it to its designated board.




- Some mobile sites may have one of these special Pinterest buttons you can tap to initiate this process.



DELETING A PIN

At some point, you may be ready to clean up your boards or you may have pinned something that you didn't want by accident.





To delete a Pin from a board, go to your profile and tap on the board where that Pin is located.

- **Tap and hold** on the Pin you want to delete from your board.
- **Choose Edit** (If your app shows the 'Delete' option, choose Delete).
- In the Edit Pin details, **tap Delete**.

If you need to update your information, link your social media accounts, or update your search privacy on Pinterest, access your settings from your profile.
